We, the CROFTERS COMMISSION, have considered an application by John William Crichton for a Direction that the site of the dwellinghouse and garden ground extending to seventy-nine decimal or one thousandth parts of a hectare (0.079 ha) or thereby, as shown delineated in black and highlighted red on the plan attached, shall cease to be part of the above croft. We are now satisfied that the extent of the said garden ground is appropriate for the reasonable enjoyment of the dwellinghouse as a residence, and so DIRECT that the said subjects shall cease to be land to which the Crofters Act applies, ON CONDITION THAT the subjects are acquired by the tenant or his nominee within five years of the date shown below.

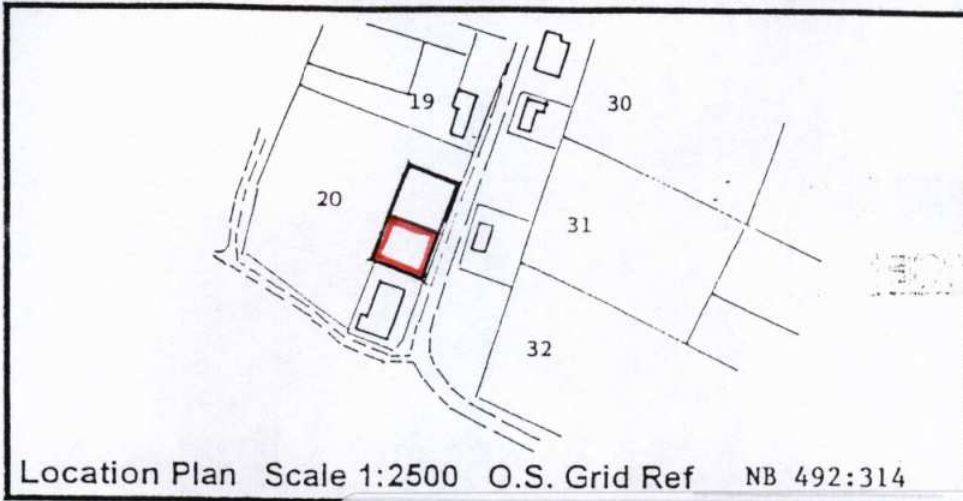

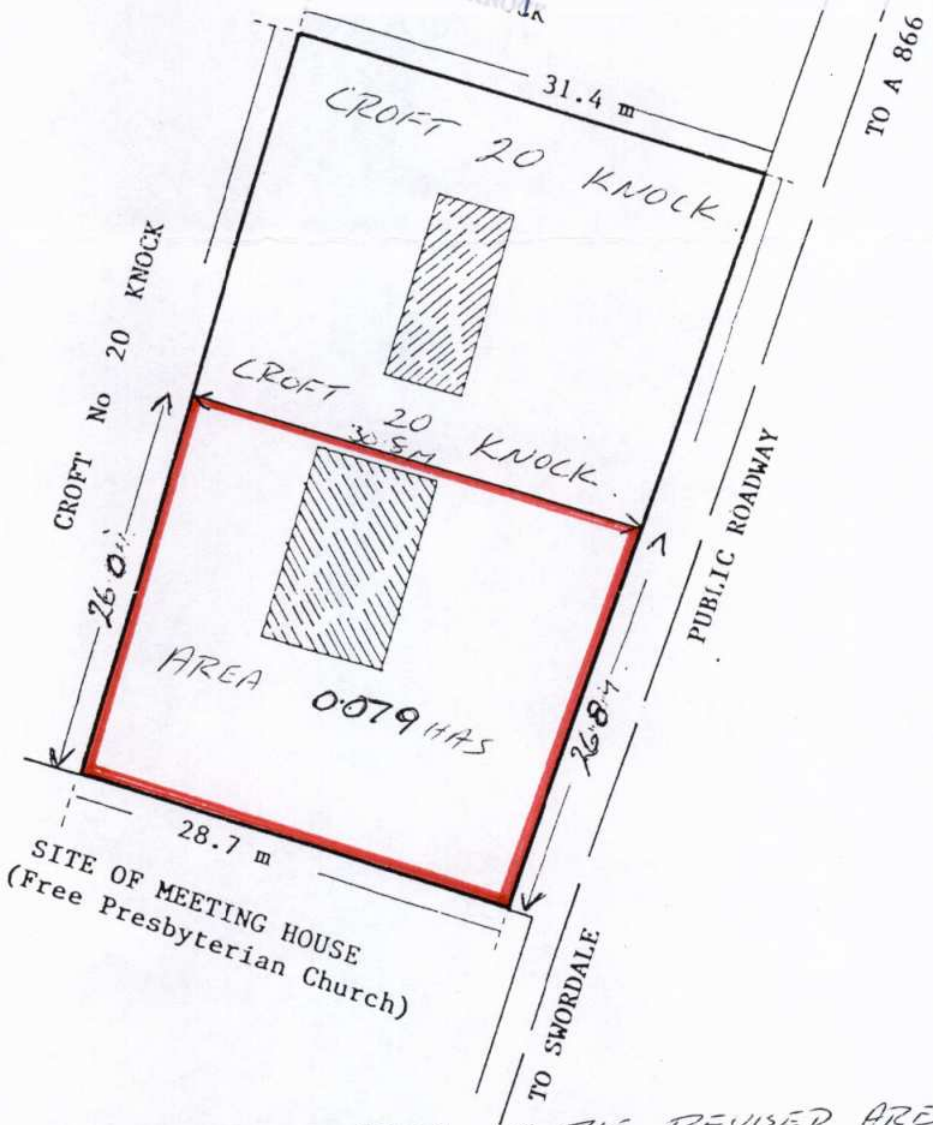
MAP. REF. 1 This is the Plan referred to in the Commission's Direction issued under Register No R4117 dated 26 May 1999.
